Attendance legislation Changes

New legislation comes into force from August 19th 2024. These changes will affect all unauthorised absence after this date. <u>Please note that we cannot authorise holidays during term time</u>. The following changes will be made:

- 10 sessions (equivalent of 5 days) of unauthorised absence over a longer time period—increased from 8 to 10 weeks—is referred to the Local Authority
- The number of penalty notices that can be issued to a parent, in respect of the same child, will be <u>two</u> penalty notices within a 3-year period, before proceeding for prosecution.
- The penalty notice increases from £120 to £160 (if paid within 28 days) or £60 to £80 (if paid within 21 days) for the <u>first penalty notice</u> issued to a parent in respect of the same child in a 3-year period.
- Any <u>second penalty notice</u> issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the date that the first penalty notice was issued increases to £160 to be paid within 28 days. No discount is offered.
- Further absences will proceed for prosecution in the Magistrate Court for the same parent in respect of the same child within <u>3 years of the date of the first penalty was</u> issued.
