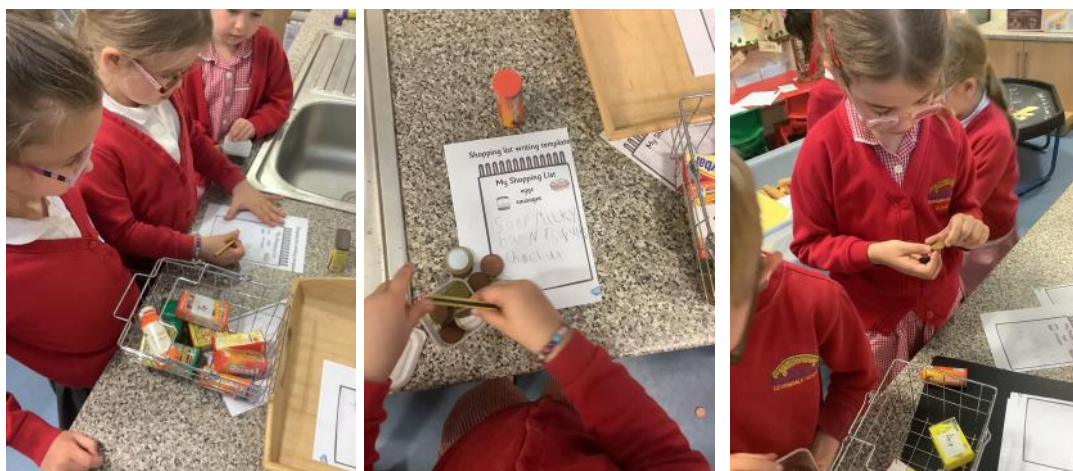

As we finally have some sunshine, children will need sun cream, a hat and a water bottle in school.

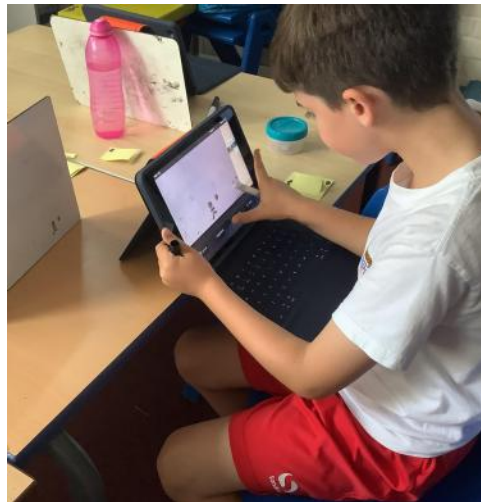
Please can we ask parents to apply sun cream before school, so that children are well-prepared for outdoor times.
