#### **Important September updates**

### Change to school start time



In September, we will be increasing the length of our school day by 10 minutes in line with National DfE Guidance to deliver a 32.5 hour school week.

Our school day will start at 8.45am, instead of 8.55am.

This will mean the whistle on the key stage one and two playgrounds will be blown at 8.45am, and children will be brought in at this time. This will be followed by a 10 minute window to complete registers and will mean that anyone arriving after 8.55am will be marked as late.

The door next to the nursery classroom, for Nursery and Reception children, will also be opened at 8.45am.

We will use this extra time in school for academic purpose such as reading, spelling practice, mindfulness activities, times tables practice or fluency activities.

#### **Attendance legislation Changes**

New legislation comes into force from August 19th 2024. These changes will affect all unauthorised absence after this date.

#### Please note that we cannot authorise holidays during term time.

The following changes will be made:

- 10 sessions (equivalent of 5 days) of unauthorised absence over a longer time period—increased from 8 to 10 weeks—is referred to the Local Authority
- The number of penalty notices that can be issued to a parent, in respect of the same child, will be two penalty notices within a 3-year period, before proceeding for prosecution.
- Schools can still refer to the Local Authority, even when parents have not requested Leave of Absence, where there is knowledge of a 10 session holiday taken in term time.
- The penalty increases from £120 to £160 (if paid within 28 days) or £60 to £80 (if paid within 21 days) for the first penalty notice issued to a parent in respect of the same child in a 3-year period.
- Any second penalty notice, issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the date that the first penalty notice was issued, increases to £160 to be paid within 28 days. No discount is offered.
- Further absences will proceed for prosecution in the Magistrate Court for the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the date of the first penalty was issued.
- There will be systems to transfer notice of penalties between schools and local authorities.
