Cyber Choices session from Cleveland Police
























Y1 have been working really hard this half term!

Recipe of the Week:



Spinach Yogurt Dip with Vegetables

4 servings 25 minutes

Ingredients

2 cups Baby Spinach

1 cup Plain Greek Yogurt

Sea Salt & Black Pepper (to taste)

1 Carrot (large, cut into sticks)

1/2 Cucumber (large, cut into sticks)

2 stalks Celery (cut into sticks)

1 Yellow Bell Pepper (medium, sliced)

Directions

Heat a pot over medium heat. Add in the spinach with a splash of water. Cook for about five to seven minutes, stirring occasionally, until the spinach is wilted.

Remove from the heat and cool slightly. Roughly chop the spinach and transfer to a bowl.

3 Add the yogurt to the spinach. Stir and season with salt and pepper.

4 Serve the dip with carrots, cucumbers, celery, and bell peppers. Enjoy!

Notes

Leftovers: Refrigerate in an airtight container for up to five days.

Serving Size: One serving is equal to approximately 1/3 cup dip and 1/2 cup vegetables.

Dairy-Free: Use plant-based yogurt instead.

Article 6

Article 24

Every child has the right to the best possible health. This includes health care, clean water, nutritious food and a clean environment and education on health and well-being so that children can stay healthy.
