


Just look at this beautiful artwork created in Mrs. Stonehouse's class this week! The children have continued their art project about spirals, using a variety of media and techniques!

This includes tinned items, like beans, tomatoes, vegetables, soups and meats. and fish. Also dried foods like pasta, rice, sauces and breakfast cereal.




